## **Grant for Top 40 Startups**

The top 40 startups selected will each be eligible to receive a total funding of \$22,727 for settlement in Korea based on performances on the 'Demo Day' and Settlement Evaluation. Distribution of funding will be as follows:

- Initial distribution: 20% of total funding in January
- Remaining distribution will be made to startups that pass the performance evaluation held in April 2019. (April: 50%, June: 30%)

# **Grant for Top 4 Startups**

1st Prize: \$100,000 (110,000,000 KRW) 2nd Prize: \$40,000 (44,000,000 KRW) 3rd Prize: \$20,000 (22,000,000 KRW) 4th Prize: \$6,000 (6,600,000 KRW) - the grant will be given in Korean Won

#### **Additional Investments**

The Accelerators may make equity investments in the most promising startups. Startups may have access to other VC's and investors who may choose to invest
